DESCRIPTION

The American Legion is the largest US veterans organization with more than 1.6 million members who strengthen the nation through programs, services and advocacy for those who have served in the US Armed Forces, youth and communities. Each year national convention delegates convene to approve changes to the Legion's constitution and bylaws, pass programs that guide the organization's direction, set membership dues, and elect a national commander and five national vice commanders to serve until the next convention. There will be attendance from all 50 states, District of Columbia, Puerto Rico, France, Latin America and the Philippines. The American Legion Auxiliary and Sons of American Legion will also hold their meetings during this conference.
